



Diane M. Halle Library At-A-Glance

- Diane M. Halle Library built in 1965; renovated 1997; expanded with a new wing in 2002.
- A wireless computing environment.
- Approximately 120,000 items in-house on shelves (books, DVDs, periodicals).
- Member of NOBLE (North of Boston Library Exchange): over 3 million items in 28 area libraries - both public and academic institutions – available to Endicott College community members.
- Integrated, user-friendly Web-based catalog allows patrons to search Endicott College library collection or any and all libraries in the NOBLE consortium with a few keystrokes.
- Endicott ID card works at every NOBLE library. Database search capabilities and automated interlibrary loan procedures enable timely access to millions of library items in thousands of libraries across the United States.
- Library-licensed journal databases allow access to over 77,000 unique journal resources, encompassing hundreds of thousands of individual journal articles supporting Endicott College's curriculum. Available to on-campus and remote users via the Library website.
- Library website features book catalog, journal listings, databases, hours & staff contact information.
- Library is open Monday through Thursday 7:30 a.m. until 12 midnight; Friday 7:30 a.m. to 8 p.m.; Saturday 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.; and Sunday 12 noon to 12 midnight during the academic year (summer and holiday hours posted separately).
- Reference personnel on-duty in library for 92 of the 96.5 operational hours of the Library (including early mornings, late nights until closing, and weekends) ensuring quality and consistency of professional service to Endicott College library patrons.
- Cyber-Café on lower level of library is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week during the academic year (can be subject to change). The Cyber-Café features a 153-seat theatre, 13 computer workstations, coffee bar, television lounge, and comfortable seating for study and relaxation.
