CYNTHIA MERKLE '77

Executive Vice President and Chief Operational Risk Officer at Eastern Bank



CYNTHIA MERKLE is one of the newest members of the Endicott College Alumni Council. After graduating from Endicott with a degree in ceramics in 1977, she did not return to campus until her five year reunion. During those five years, she moved home to Eastern Providence and worked as a bank teller.

Cynthia soon realized that she enjoyed the business environment and made the decision that art would be a hobby, rather than a profession. She was hired by a bank in Providence as the

branch manager, where she led several departments. Soon after, she was recruited to work for Fleet Bank – which later became Bank of America – where she was Vice President.

During her years prior to Eastern Bank, she went back to school at Bryant College in Rhode Island and pursued a degree in management and marketing. In 1991, Cynthia was recruited by Eastern Bank on the North Shore, where she is now the Executive Vice President and the Chief Operational Risk Officer. Here, she leads the Management Accounting Department, Corporate Call Center, and the Compliance and Operational Risk Department.

Before getting involved with the Alumni Council, Cynthia had returned to campus to speak to students in the School of Business on management, leadership, and team building. She could not believe what the two-year women's college she graduated from had transformed into! "The changes are absolutely amazing," Cynthia stated, and "the education that students receive is great."

Outside of her work life, Cindy is dedicated to her community. She is on the Board of Directors of the Massachusetts Mortgage Bankers Charitable Foundation. The foundation is committed to affordable housing in the Commonwealth. She is also President of Girls Incorporated in Lynn, which is dedicated to inspiring girls to be strong, smart, and bold. In her town of residency, she received the Town of Swampscott's Distinguished Service Award.

Cindy and her husband, Philip, reside in Swampscott. They have two daughters, Hana and Sarah, who both also have a passion for community. Hana is a graduate of Harvard University and is a program director for Teach for America, which is committed to eliminating educational inequality. She began with the organization as a teacher in West Oakland, California and now is a director in Boston. Sarah has a passion for art, as her mother does, and is a senior at CalArts in Los Angeles.

Although Cynthia does not use her specific degree from Endicott in her work life, she credits her experiences here as the foundation on how to learn, work in a team environment, and manage. She is excited to get involved while on the Alumni Council, specifically with mentoring current students in fields relating to medicine, business, and the arts.

REMEMBERING NADINE BOLEN



ON APRIL 22, 2010 fellow alumna and member of the Endicott family, Nadine Bolen lost her battle with cancer, and we lost a beautiful and cherished friend.

Born in Boston on March 2, 1957 to Robert and Mary “Betty” Bolen, Nadine attended Marlboro and Boxford schools and graduated from Masconomet Regional High School in 1975. She earned a degree in Business Administration at Endicott in 2006. She leaves her parents, three sisters, a brother, and her daughters, Sarah and Jennifer Lambert.

Nadine began her career at Endicott in 1995 as a coordinator in the Office of Admission, where her gift for connecting with people became apparent. In 1997, she joined the Development Office (Admissions still has a hard time forgiving us), and she earned a number of promotions in the institutional advancement and alumni offices, becoming the Director of Alumni Relations in 2007. Many of our alumni developed close friendships with Nadine, and she valued those relationships.



A celebration of her life was held in the College Chapel on April 28, and in accordance with Nadine’s wishes, everyone wore a splash of color. Dr. Wylie noted the College community’s desire to create a lasting tribute to Nadine, and he announced the establishment of the Nadine Bolen Memorial Scholarship, which will be awarded annually to a student who, like Nadine, portrays caring values and concern for others and who makes outstanding contributions to the College community.



Nadine was one of those special people whose energy is contagious. Generous with her smile and with her friendship, she touched the lives of our students, alumni, and staff. We are saddened by her loss, and we are deeply grateful that through the generous support
