

# Misselwood to hold Bridal Open House this weekend

Local couples looking to wed on the North Shore may not have to look any further than Beverly. Endicott College's venues, Misselwood and Tupper Manor, were recently recognized as two of the premier nuptial locations in the area. This weekend, couples will get a sneak peek at what Misselwood has to offer, as the venue will hold its annual Bridal Open House on Sunday, March 11 from 1-3 p.m.

It comes as no surprise then that the ocean view estate was just voted "The Best of Weddings 2012" by wedding advice magazine The Knot.

"2012 marks the seventh wedding season for Endicott College's Misselwood," said Geyer in a press release. "We are thrilled to have received this honor for a second year in a row. This award demonstrates that our wedding venue is exceptional and that the staff's attention to detail and professionalism consistently exceeds our clients' expectations."

Each year, The Knot presents wedding industry professionals with The Best of Weddings Award, based on superior client reviews and recommendations from wedding vendors. Misselwood also scooped up the award last year.

"What's special about us is that we're more of a one-stop shop," said Geyer.

Misselwood also has the advantage of bordering the Atlantic Ocean, allowing for couples to get creative with their wedding. Geyer recalled one bride and groom who swiftly sailed past their guests on a boat after the reception.
