Endicott College and Rethink Autism will present “Innovations and Technology in the Education of Children With Autism” on Saturday, May 1, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., at the Wylie Inn and Conference Center Meeting Place, 376 Hale St., Beverly.

Presenters are Bridget Taylor, co-founder the Alpine Learning Group and senior clinical advisor for Rethink Autism, and Jamie Pagliaro, co-creator of Rethink Autism and former head of the New York Center for Autism Charter School.

This presentation will provide an overview of the latest innovations in teaching children with autism. A wide range of skills will be addressed, including improving language and social skills and incorporating peers to teach observational learning skills. Interventions will be illustrated via case examples along with video examples of specific teaching interventions.

There will also be an overview of key components in establishing and maintaining evidence-based autism programs. An innovative, web-based autism curriculum and training platform will be reviewed to support autism intervention at home and in the public schools.
