

Double Major Proposal Form

A double major is the completion of two majors that fall within the same degree designation such as Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science. When undertaking a double major, students must meet the course requirements of both majors. Double majors are not possible in highly structured majors, particularly those that have accreditation or licensing requirements such as interior design or nursing. Students interested in double majors must plan for that option as early as possible, preferably no later than the second semester of the freshman year. Depending on the major and potential scheduling conflicts, students may not be able to complete the requirements of both majors within eight semesters and may have to take January intersession or summer courses. In addition, the full semester internship and thesis that you undertake must integrate both majors. In order to proceed, you must complete a proposal and obtain the approval of the deans of both majors. Please follow the steps outlined below.
